

**2018 Amateur Photography Contest**  
**at the Bakerville Library Annual Potluck Pig Roast**

**Submission Deadline: Wednesday, August 8, 6:00 pm**

1. Eligibility

This contest is open only to amateur photographers. An amateur photographer is someone that takes photos for fun and passion. They enjoy the art of photography and appreciate the ability to preserve memories and moments. Despite being an amateur, they can and do make some of the most beautiful and breathtaking images you'll ever see.

2. Photo Eligibility

Any photograph of scenes, events or people in New Hartford, CT taken by you, the amateur.

3. Categories

The categories are by age:

- a. Up to eighteen years old
- b. Eighteen and over

You may submit up to four photos.

4. Size and mounting

Entries should be 8x10, black and white or color and must be mounted on mount board, poster board or in a photo mat with the opening 5x7 or 8x10. Do not frame photos.

5. Contest Entry Information

Each photo submitted must be labeled on the back with the photographer's name, address, phone number, and age. Do not put any identification on the front of the photo. There is no entry fee. Each photographer must submit a completed Entry Form.

6. Submitting photos

Photos must be submitted to the Bakerville Library by 6:00 pm on Wednesday, August 8.

7. Judging

New Hartford residents Carol Taylor (Printmaker) and Clayton Taylor (Photographer) will judge the entries before the beginning of the Pig Roast on Saturday, August 11. Criteria include composition, lighting, impact, and center of interest.

8. Prizes

There will be first, second and third place ribbons awarded in each of the two categories. Additionally, the winning photos will be posted on the Bakerville Library website and first place photos will be shown in the Library's newsletter.

9. Usage rights

All photographs submitted to the competition remain the sole property of the photographer. By entering this amateur photography contest you agree that the Bakerville Library board of directors has the right to use the photographs entered in Library publications and publicity efforts without compensation. Ownership information will be supplied whenever the Library uses the photo but the Board of Directors takes no responsibility for any third party use.

10. Photo Contest Exhibit

All entries will be on display beginning with the Pig Roast August 11 and continuing to September 29. Photos may be picked up during regular Library hours after Saturday, September 29.

11. Handling of prints

All care will be taken with your entry photographs but the Library Board assumes no responsibility for lost or damaged photos.
